Agreement for Consignment of New Corsets

Farthingales L.A. Inc. will consider taking corsets on consignment. Corsets must meet certain standards and even if these standards appear to be met in the opinion of the client (consignor) Farthingales L.A. Inc. (consignee) has the right to refuse acceptance. Basic standards are as follows:

- All corsets offered must be fresh and never worn.
- All corsets offered must be free of any scent or contaminating elements such as stains or pet hair.
- All corsets offered must appear to have been professionally made – all bindings neatly finished, no loose or dangling threads, straight parallel bone casings, no gaps or stressed seams.

If you think your corsets meet these criteria then Farthingales is interested in seeing them to assess them for our consignment rack. If your corset(s) don't meet all of the above criteria please do not bring/send them to Farthingales L.A. Inc. ***For a complete list of characteristics we will be looking for see page 3.***

Corsets for consignment will not be accepted on Saturdays. Please DO NOT bring corsets for consignment on Saturday. Please call 310-392-1787 to make an appointment to bring you corset in for assessment by our staff. Tuesday evenings are the best time for these appointments if possible. ***Corsets may also be mailed or shipped to us at your expense see the details on page 2.***

Consignment corsets (new, unused) will be put out on the racks on the first of each month in order to keep things organized. This means that all corsets that come in and are accepted during a month will be stored until the 1st of the following month when all will go out on the "New Corset" consignment rack. All consignment corsets will then have 90 days of opportunity to sell before we will return them to you. Corsets that do not sell will be returned to you via US Post C.O.D. This means you will be required to pay for their return delivery.

Corsets will not be bought outright. Payment for consignment corsets that have sold will be paid by cheque at the end of each month. If you bring only one corset in on the 3rd day of a month it will not go out onto the racks until the 1st day of the following month and it will have 90 days on the rack, if it sells in the first month you will be issued a cheque on the last day of that month. If you have more than one corset you will be issued a cheque for all corsets sold either once they have all sold or at the end of the 90 day period at which time a cheque will be sent to you along with the corsets that did not sell and are being returned to you. Example: You bring a corset in on the 10th of October, it goes on the rack on the 1st of November and if it does not sell it is shipped back to you the first week of February, having had 90 days of opportunity to sell. We will make every effort to sell your corset as it is in our best interest to do so.

When corsets are accepted by Farthingales L.A. Inc. you will be given/mailed a receipt with the description of the corset(s) and the amount that you will be paid (in the event that your corset(s) gets sold by Farthingales L.A. Inc.) and the date they will be shipped back to you if they do not sell.

Procedures for Submitting a Corset for Consignment

1. Decide if your corset meets the criteria for acceptance by Farthingales L.A. Inc. Look carefully at the criteria on page 3. If your corset(s) don't meet our standards they will not be accepted and will be returned directly to you at your cost! Be critical – we will be.
2. Print off the Consignment Agreement on Page 4 and fill it in.
3. Use our "Pricing Scale" *found on page 3* to determine the \$ amount you want to receive for the corset. Be realistic.
4. Label your corset
 - size (waist, bust, hip) & style # if you have one
 - details – example silk brocade, poly taffeta, denim - whatever
And type of bones, type of construction (double or single layer). Historic Time period if there is one.
 - your name/company name and contact information
 - price you want to be paid for the corset if it sells. *Based on Price Scale see pg. 3*
The more details the better! The more we know about your corset the better we can promote it.
5. Ship your corset to us using a traceable and insurable method. Include your signed Consignment Agreement. (see step 2 above)

Express Post is cost effective and offers both of these services.

6. Call and make an appointment to bring your corset in for assessment. Tuesday evenings are usually best for appointments. The assessment will not occur with you in room so do be prepared to take a stroll as our staff need to concentrate in order to assess your corset and they will be more likely to accept your product if they can focus on the details and not feel pressured or rushed.
7. Do not argue the result of our assessment. It won't get us to change our mind. If we don't accept your corset please don't send it to us again later! Chances are you just need a bit more experience in the finishing details so keep at it. The finishing details are very important and the most common weak point, do not feel offended.
8. Keep your receipt. If we accept your corset(s) we will either mail or give you a receipt for it. The receipt will include the # of corsets, their descriptions, and the amount that will be owed to you if they sell. The receipt will be attached to a Consignment Agreement – the one you printed off the internet, filled in and sent along with your corset(s) or the one filled out by our staff when you brought your corset(s) in.

Consignment Corset Criteria... What we are looking for

- All corsets offered must be fresh and show NO signs of wear.
- All corsets offered must be free of any scent or contaminating elements such as pet hair, marks or stains. Presentation is important! We will not clean your corset up – it will be sent directly back to you C.O.D.
- All corsets offered must appear to have been professionally made – all bindings neatly finished, no loose or dangling threads, no wobbly unparallel bone casings, no gaps or stressed seams.
- We will consider any size provided you know the waist, hip and bust measures it was built for.
- We prefer corsets made with a fine coutil foundation.
- We prefer corsets that are NOT heavy and bulky due to being built on a heavy twill foundation.
- We will consider most styles with the exception of latex corsets.
- We prefer to have unique one of a kind corsets and these will be given precedence, however we will take more ordinary corsets as well – quality workmanship is more important than style.

Pricing Scale

Basic waist cinchers & under bust corsets – unembellished	\$ 90.00
Basic over bust corset – unembellished	\$120.00
Basic waist cinchers & under bust corsets – all silks/brocades	\$105.00
Basic over bust corset – all silks or brocades	\$135.00
“Art” waist cinchers & under bust corsets	\$150 to \$500.00
“Art” over bust corset	\$500 - \$1,000.00

“Art” corsets will be accepted and a premium will be offered for them. If you have a corset with hand beading or embroidery that is truly exquisite in every way we will be willing to offer up to \$1,000.00 for them. Workmanship must be flawless and they must truly be “works of art”. Farthingales hopes to develop an “art” corset clientele and will appreciate your efforts in this direction. Leather and Latex is being done elsewhere and we see no need to compete in this market.

Delivery Responsibility

You the consignor are responsible for all costs involved in delivering the corset(s) to Farthingales L.A. Inc. We highly recommend you use a shipping method which is traceable and insurable if you are not delivering your corset(s) yourself.

Corsets that do not sell in the designated time period will be shipped back to you C.O.D. which means you will be responsible for paying the shipping of unsold corset(s) back to you. They will be shipped via US Post using a traceable and insurable method.

Due to the potential need to ship C.O.D. this means we cannot accept corsets from outside of the USA at this time.
